PLACER COUNTY WINNER ADVANCES TO STATE FINALS

The Arts Council of Placer County (ACPC) hosted its annual Poetry Out Loud Competition for Placer County on February 18, 2023. The competition was held at Granite Bay High School in the campus' Theatre at 10:00 am -12:30 pm. Participating high-schools in the competition were: Granite Bay High and John Adams. Lead instructors assisting with organizing the student competitors were: Julie Francesconi, of Granite Bay High and Karin Anderson, representing John Adams. The exciting event brought out a talented group of 6 students to recite poems before an intimate audience of friends, family and supporters. The competing students were: Sarah Baker, Levi Hoover, Kaleia Norris, Elizabeth Polishchuk, Madylin Webster and Sarah Yee. The students recited the following poems: Jabberwocky, The Wooden Toy, No, I Wasn't Meant to Love and Be Loved, The Heaven of Animals, The More Loving One, and The Legend.

ACPC Board Member and Poetry Out Loud Coordinator, Delgreta Brown, assembled a panel of seven Judges for the competition. The volunteer Judges came from a variety of backgrounds in the Literary and Performing Arts. A few areas of expertise from the Judges included: published Poets, Journalists, literary magazine Editors, Musicians, Spoken Word Artists, Theatre Actors and Writers. The esteemed Judges were: Raquel Ruiz, J. Ross Parelli, Isaac "Ike" Torres, Omari Tau, Claire White, Zuzu Schmitke and Sara Knudson.
